


AMERICAN FREEDOM ALLIANCE FILM SERIES

The Rape of Europa

Please join us for the next AFA Cinema Gateway Sunday, September 13 featuring the outstanding film The Rape of Europa. The screening will begin at 7:00 pm at Factor's Deli Elm Collection, located across the street from the entrance to Factor's.

Following the screening we will be joined for a discussion of the important issues raised in the film with Neil Friedman, producer of The Rape of Europa. Narrated by Joan Allen, The Rape of Europa tells the epic story of the systematic theft, deliberate destruction and miraculous survival of Europe's art treasures during the Third Reich and the Second World War. In a journey through seven countries, the film takes the audience into the violent whirlwind of fanaticism, greed, and warfare that threatened to wipe out the artistic heritage of Europe including the story of artist Gustav Klimt's famed Gold Portrait, stolen from Viennese Jews in 1938 and now the most expensive painting ever sold.

Today, more than sixty years later, the legacy of this tragic history continues to play out as families of looted collectors recover major works of art, conservators repair battle damage, and nations fight over the fate of ill-gotten spoils of war.
